What is Duke of Edinburgh's Award (DEA)?

The Duke of Edinburgh's Award program is an exciting self-development program available to youth in over 131 countries. The program offers an individual challenge and encourages young people to undertake exciting, constructive, challenging and enjoyable activities in their free time. ULAB is a proud member of DEA since 2012.

Eligibility

Any student aged 14-25 is eligible for the award program.

How to Achieve the Award?

Students have to do four kinds of activity during the award program. Each activity requires one hour per week. Award Leaders will help the students to do these activities. Only successful students will achieve the award.

Benefits of the Award

- **Worldwide Recognition**
- Helps to get **scholarship** worldwide
- Preference in the **Job Market**
- Involvement with **international organizations**
- International network of awardees
- Development of life skills- negotiation, management, leadership, communication etc.

Levels of the Award

There are three levels of the award program

- **Bronze** (time duration 3-6 months)
- **Silver** (time duration 6 months)
- **Gold** (time duration 12 months)

Sections of the Award Program

- Social Services
- Skill Development
- Physical Recreation
- Adventure Journey

(ULAB DEA authority helps students to select and do these activities)

Cost of Award process

Students have to pay a minimal amount to enroll in the Award Program.

Enrollment Fees: **Bronze -1200TK** **Silver-1300TK** **Gold-1500TK**

How to Enroll in DEA program?

1. Accounts Department (Campus A lobby, Mr. Nawab Ali will receive the enrollment fees)
2. After paying fees, Students will contact Students Affairs office (Campus B, 1st Floor) to receive their documents.
3. DEA Authority will assign the students under an Award Leader and students will start the award activity with 2 weeks of his/her enrollment date.
